Eddie Returns

The saying goes it is always nice to go home and Georgetown College assistant Eddie Eviston could not agree more. He has gotten to do it more than once in his professional career. He returned to his native town of Newport as head coach at Newport Central Catholic.



Then this past spring stepped on the campus at Georgetown as offensive coordinator.

"This is home," Eviston said. "It is refreshing and not much has changed.

There are some new faces that I'm meeting, but it's nice to be back."

Thursday's home opener brings him full circle for the Tigers.

Eviston will step onto iHigh.com Field as a coach, trying to guide a quarterback that has received a lot of comparison to Eviston, a three-time NAIA Player of the Year and Hall of Famer.

Neal Pawsat has been under center since the fourth game his freshman year. He has thrown for 5,607 yards and 50 touchdowns. Eviston threw for 7,444 yards in his first two seasons and 68 touchdowns.

Eviston understands the pressure Pawsat is under.

"The offense we run, the quarterback is a big deal and it is not a position for everyone," Eviston

Tigers, Panthers cat fight should be fun to watch

For a team as successful as Georgetown College football program is, a season ending as this past year did can leave an unusual feeling that most of the athletes and coaches yearn to get out of their system.

Thursday night will be that opportunity for most of the 2012 team that lost in a last gasp to Bethel University in the opening round of the NAIA Football Championship Series.

"As far as days and months, this off-season has been long, but it's been good," said GC coach Bill Cronin. "We have been disciplined and inspired to work hard. We've grown together. This summer period has been longer because we are opening later, but I think we needed that time as we are a younger group this year. We needed time to get them acclimated to what we do and it all worked out well.

"I think it is probably hardest on the group of seniors that left. They have

no chance to jump on that field, but the rest of them are young and they recover quickly as they should. You might see some of that come out in week two, but our focus is on week one right now against a very good Ohio Dominican team."

The Panthers started football started football in 2004 as an NAIA school. They have since built the program up and transitioned to NCAA Division II in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. ODU was 7-3 in the GLIAC and 8-3 overall in 2012.

"They have done things the right way, and I have a lot of respect for them," Cronin said. "They are well coached and play hard. They are used to winning, and I expect they expect the same when we kick it off Thursday night under the lights.

"That is what will make this a great match-up. Both programs are used to winning and expect to win when on the football field."

The Panthers finished 8-3, 7-3 in conference play, a season ago for its best record under fourth year coach Bill Conley. It capped the stellar season with five straight wins and took second place in the GLIAC. ODU rewrote the record books in rushing yards, touchdowns, yards per game and yards per carry and was also ranked among the nations best in those categories. The Panthers finished 12th nationally in scoring offense with 40.8 ppg.

Bill Conley enters his fourth season at the helm of the Panthers after returning from retirement in 2010. Before walking the sidelines at ODU, he was an assistant two different times for Ohio State. He coached legendary players such as Cris Carter, Chris Spielman, Mike Vrabel and Mike Nugent. Carter recently mentioned his former coach in his Hall of Fame Induction speech.

Conley has helped the Panthers steadily improve from a 2-8 record in 2010 to a 8-3 mark in 2012.

He is an Ohio State graduate and played on two Big Ten championship teams, including the 1968 National Championship team under legendary coach Woody Hayes.
